



## Understanding Your Revolution Bill

To understand your bill, you will need to understand the charges, taxes, and fees.

### Internet Service:

This charge is based on the internet package you have chosen. \*  
(At this time, there are no taxes or fees associated with internet services.)

### Telephone Service:

This charge is based on the type of phone service you receive. \*

\* Please note: Revolution bills one month in advance. The first bill you receive will include prorated charges for the month your service was installed, the current month of charges, and the pre-paid month of charges.

**Government Programs Fees and Taxes:** Revolution is required to charge you certain fees to support state, federal, and local government programs and taxes. These fees and taxes are subject to change based on information provided by regulatory authorities.

Current Revolution taxes and fees:

PA Telecommunications Relay Surcharge supports the system that provides relay service for deaf, hard of hearing, and/or persons with speech and language disorders enabling them to communicate via telephone with the assistance of a trained Communications Assistant (CA).

PA Uniform 911 Surcharge supports the local and state 911 emergency dialing and dispatch systems.

Federal USF Recovery Surcharge is a pass-through telephone charge that Revolution pays to support the Universal Service Fund.

The FUSF is a government program that funds programs to keep local phone service affordable for all Americans by providing discounts on services to schools, libraries, healthcare facilities, and people living in rural and high-cost areas.

PA Sales Tax and PA Gross Receipts Recovery Surcharge are a pass-through of the state taxes applied to your service.
